Some signs of abuse

Physical Signs

- Unusual drowsiness
- Dizziness
- Constricted (small) pupils
- Slowed breathing
- Constipation

Behavioral Signs

- Extreme mood swings
- More absences from work
- Consistently late to work
- Withdrawal from friends, coworkers and family
